That is, a conflict exists before any actual breach of trust, and irrespective of whether a breach of trust actually occurs.

Disclosure pertains to any financial relationship with an organisation or company, e.g., pharmaceutical company, biomedical device manufacturer, or other corporation, whose products or services are related to the subject matter handled by the Committee member. The information will be kept on file to comply with accreditation and regulatory requirements and to insure EAHP's security and integrity are protected.
